

Food festival focus on local flavours

The Go for 2 & 5 Gascoyne Food Festival is fast approaching, with a number of special events and talented chefs set to highlight the region's best local flavours.

From August 13 to 16, foodies and chefs from around the country will flock to the Gascoyne for events including the paddock-to-plate experience of the chef's tour, family-style dining at the barbecue on the beach, the premier long-table lunch at Bentwaters Plantation and the Gascoyne Growers' Markets.

In a festival first, the shires of Shark Bay and Exmouth will also be hosting two mouth-watering events.

Dirk's Dinner Plate is to be held on Dirk Hartog Island at Cape Inscription and Surf and Turf on Sunrise Beach will be held in Exmouth, hosted by the Novotel Ningaloo.

Chefs from well-known Perth restaurants, including Poach Pear, The Print Hall, The Peasant's Table, Fraser's Restaurant, Incontro, the Atrium Buffet, Ultimo Catering, Musk Wine Bar and the Old Brewery will be joining the event.

"The festival provides chefs with a unique opportunity to network with each other and to meet with growers to learn more about the provenance of produce," said Print Hall executive chef Dan Fisher.

"It's also really rewarding to be able to use our creativity at the long-table lunch in such a stunning location."

Gascoyne Food Council acting executive officer Doriana Mangili said the event will mark the sixth
